Will there be grandstands for viewing? - This event will feature grandstands available to the general public. Located on the back straight in the fan zone, the grandstands will be available on a first-come, first served basis.

What is "Paddock Access"? - The Paddock is the working area for the teams, and provides an excellent opportunity to get up close to the race cars and drivers of the IndyCar and Grand-Am Series. Each person entering the Paddock must purchase a separate Paddock Access pass, either in advance or at the entrance to the Paddock, located at Gate 7. This pass grants admission into the paddock area Friday-Sunday. A general admission ticket is needed for admittance onto the grounds. Paddock passes are non-transferable, and the paddock wristband is void if cut

What is the "Speed Pass"? - The Speed Pass is the ultimate credential for any motorsports fan, including a three-day admission ticket, paddock access, on-site parking and a pit pass. Limited amounts are available. The pit pass grants admission into the paddock area and pit lane (non-race modes) during select sessions Friday-Sunday of the Indy Grand Prix of Alabama. In the interest of safety, Barber Motorsports Park reserves the right to alter pit lane access at any time. Long pants and closed-toe shoes are required and you must be 18 years of age to be admitted into pit lane. Pit passes are not available for individual purchase.

What is the "The Billy's Sports Grill Club Ticket"? - This ticket is for the IndyCar fan who wants to enjoy the race weekend in style! The club is a sports bar-type atmosphere located trackside at turn 14 just before Pit In. Limited amounts are available. Access to the Club gives you complimentary breakfast, lunch and afternoon snacks, as well as beer, wine and other drink specials which will be provided by Billy's Sports Grill. The Club will also offer access to an outdoor patio, as well as TV monitors inside that feature live race coverage. The "Club Ticket" includes three-day general admission and Club access, on-site parking pass and paddock access.

What if I would like to buy a Season Pass? - 2010 Barber Motorsports Park Season Passes are available for \$225. This includes 3 day General Admission / Paddock Access to the Indy Grand Prix of Alabama/Grand Am Road Race and AMA Superbike Classic. This also includes general admission to all other spectator events at Barber. If you purchase a "Speed Pass" or Billy's Sports Grill Club Pass, you may add a 2010 season pass for \$125.00.

How do I get to different areas of Barber Motorsports Park? - A tram service will be provided at no charge for all spectators. The tram will stop at seven (7) different locations throughout the park. The tram service will start each day at 7:30 a.m. and will run until 6:30 p.m. or 1 ½ hours after the conclusion of racing activity.

Can I park at the Barber Motorsports Park? - Because of the size of the event, on-site parking (cars & motorcycles) at the Barber Motorsports Park will be limited to those individuals possessing an on-site parking pass. These limited-number passes are available to purchase in advance on a first-come, first-serve basis. All spectators without a parking credential will be instructed to park at the designated off-site areas. Free shuttles, including ADA accessible, will transport spectators to and from the Park (expected ride time is less than fifteen minutes).

Will there be a Sports Car Corral during this weekend? - Yes. A limited number of parking passes will be made available to our car club partners, which will allow on-site access for parking. Additional information will be sent to our car club partners in early November.

What is the admissions policy for Kids? - Kids twelve (12) and under are admitted free with a ticketed adult. This is for general admission only. Kids of all ages must purchase a paddock pass to enter the paddock, and have a hospitality pass to enter any of the designated hospitality areas.

What are my camping choices? - The Barber Motorsports Park will have limited amounts of tent and motorhome camping available this spring for race fans. Tent camping, as well as motorhome camping, have been relocated just off turn 14 at the new Lot D. Premium Hilltop motorhome camping will remain in its traditional space overlooking the Park, with a limited number of spots available (41). There are no hook ups available in these areas. Each camper must be self sufficient. There will be a vendor onsite to handle potable and gray water service. A phone number for the vendor will be provided in the camping materials sent on March 1st. There will be an additional charge for this service. Each tent or motorhome pass will also receive a tow behind vehicle pass for easy access to and from the park. Again, camping and motorhome space is limited, so be sure to purchase yours today!

Can I volunteer for the Indy Grand Prix of Alabama? - Yes, we are always in need of hard-working, dedicated volunteers! Information regarding committees and opportunities will be made available via the Indy Grand Prix of Alabama website beginning November 16th.

Where is the Barber Motorsports Park? - Located just off of exit 140 on I-20, the Park is convenient to many areas of Birmingham. Hotels, restaurants and shopping are less than a 15 minutes away, as well as Birmingham International Airport.

What is the Barber Vintage Motorsports Museum? - Located on-site at the Barber Motorsports Park, the Museum is home to the world's largest collection of motorcycles and Lotus sports cars. Featuring 600+ motorcycles and cars on display, the collection represents over 200 different manufacturers from 20 countries. Of these, 99% can be run within one hour! Although admission to the Museum is not included with an IndyCar Grand Prix of Alabama ticket, it will be available for purchase during your visit.
