Tickets on sale for 2011 AMA Superbike Classic at Barber Motorsports Park

Birmingham, Ala. (Mar. 31) – Barber Motorsports Park and ZOOM Motorsports announced today that tickets are on sale for the AMA Superbike Classic to be held June 17-19, 2011, at the Barber Motorsports Park. Last fall's season-ending championship brought more than 40,000 fans from all over the world to watch the best of the series compete on the twists and turns of the 2.38 mile road course at Barber Motorsports Park.

The 2011 race will mark AMA Pro Road Racing's ninth visit to the spectacular Alabama road racing complex. This year's event, returning back to its traditional spring date, will again feature the most dominant names in AMA Pro Racing. In addition, the weekend will include fan walks on Pit Lane, autograph sessions and much more.

AMA Pro National Guard SuperBike, AMA Pro Daytona SportBike, AMA Pro Motorcycle-Superstore.com SuperSport and AMA Pro Vance & Hines XR1200 series will compete at the June 17-19 weekend. In SuperSport, this will be an East Division event.

Among the many ticket options this year, are 3-day General Admission tickets for only \$50, and 3-day Paddock Upgrades with access to the teams' garage areas for an additional \$15. Spectators can select from a variety of individual and 3-day tickets ranging in price from \$10 to \$50 and are encouraged to purchase tickets in advance, as prices will increase the week of the race.
