Helio Castroneves, a three-time winner of the Indy 500 and winner of ABC's *Dancing with the Stars*, is the defending champion of the event.

This year's event will again feature the most dominant names in the IndyCar Series, including Danica Patrick, Dario Franchitti, Will Power, and more. In addition, the weekend will include the Grand-Am Rolex Series featuring the Porsche 250 race, as well as the Continental Tire Sports Car Challenge, Fan Walks on Pit Lane, autograph sessions and much more.

Among the many ticket options this year, are 3-day General Admission tickets for only \$70, and the new and improved Billy's Sports Grill Club, a trackside hospitality area with a sports bar atmosphere located between turns 14 and 15. Spectators can select from a variety of tickets ranging in price from \$15 to \$425 and are encouraged to purchase tickets in advance, as prices will increase the week of the race.
