The cost to volunteer is \$35.00 for one event, \$50.00 for two events and \$65.00 for all three events.

2010 Volunteer Committee Descriptions

- Hillside Marshals** Responsible for marshaling the spectator areas to keep pop-up tents behind the designated line and enforcing park rules.
- Paddock Credentials** Responsible for having waivers signed and selling paddock passes for anyone entering the paddock area.
- Paddock Marshals** Responsible for pedestrian and vehicular traffic in the paddock area.
- Race Control Security** Responsible for checking credentials and monitoring security at the Race Control Building.
- Communications** Responsible for charging and distributing radios.
- Sponsor Hospitality** Responsible for checking credentials at the hospitality entrances as well as ensuring the sponsors' needs are met.
- Fan Zone** Responsible for making sure spectator foot traffic is flowing freely. Making sure spectators and vendors are following park rules.
- Volunteer Check-In** Responsible for checking-in volunteers and distributing meal vouchers.
- Water and Ice** Responsible for making sure all coolers are filled with drinks and water each morning and replenished throughout the day.

Please note, not all committees will be used for every race. Committees needed for each race will be listed below the shift information on page 3 of this application.

Shift times will vary depending on the race.
